

Registrar (Junior / Senior): This will involve assisting in player registrations and working closely with the treasurer in ensuring player fees have been paid, ensuring player eligibility to play games, managing player transfers and general management of the club memberships. You will need to have access to a computer as this will involve working with the Hockey Qld online registrations system.

Coaches: We had a high participation level this year and would like to continue to grow from that. Members that participate in coaching a team in 2017 will receive an incentive package. Managers: We are seeking managers for the same teams as above. Your role would be primarily player liaison on behalf of the coach and performing tech bench duties at game times.

Grants Officer / Fund Raising Committee: The club has already been successful in obtaining grant funding in conjunction with GCHA and other Community Benefit Funds. This is a very important part for maintaining funding levels within the club so that we can continue with some of the programs that we have introduced over the last 12 months. The club requires a person or persons who would be willing to seek out funding grants and submit applications on behalf of the club. This role would also be required to come up with and organise various fund raising activities during the year, eg Bunnings Sausage Sizzle day

Events Coordinator / Social Committee: We are seeking a person or persons to organise various events and social gatherings. This would range from maybe family fun days, club dinner, our Roosters Hockey Club day and Junior/Senior Presentation events

Website Administrator: This role would be assisting in updating and managing the pages on the website and ensuring the website is displaying up to date information as it pertains to our members.

Social Media Coordinator: This would be a similar position to the Website Administrator but will be related to the updating and posting on the club's Facebook page and the possible additions of Twitter and/or Instagram. This may even form part of the same role as the Website Administrator.

Uniform & Equipment Coordinator: This person would be responsible for distribution of uniforms, and club clothing such as polo shirts and hoodies, and ensuring we have suitable stocks available and liaising with organisations for obtaining additional uniform or equipment supplies as required by the club throughout the season.
